The 89'ers then charged into the C.I.F. play-offs. Our Cavaliers took down Morningside 18-0 in the first round, they followed that up by defeating Arroyo Grande 32-25. Then easily beat Notre Dame 12-3 in the semifinals. The Championship game loomed as Serra's Cavaliers met up against mighty Lompoc on December 9, 1989 at El Camino College. Lompoc featured Napoleon Kauffman at running back, who later starred for the Oakland Raiders. But mightier Serra took an early lead and led all the way.
